

Internal regulations

Dear camper,

Welcome to « Le Cheslez » campsite. We wish you a pleasant stay.

Please respect the following rules so that everyone can enjoy the campsite :

- Departures are from 8am to 12pm.
- Please respect the calm on the pitch. You are asked for silence after 10:30 p.m.!
Your neighbors may already be sleeping!
- The gate is closed between 11.00 p.m. and 7 a.m. If you arrive after 11:00 p.m., you must park your car in the parking lot. If you have to leave the campsite before 7:00 a.m., you must put your car in the parking lot before 11:00 p.m. the day before. In case of emergency (illness, accident, doctor, ...) you can always call the number 071 61 26 32, so that we can open the barrier.
- We are careful with our waste so please sort your bins. There are bins for sorting in the wooden shed near the reception.
- Chemical toilets must be emptied only in the designated area next to the garbage cans.
- Dogs are allowed, of course always on a leash and provided they do not disturb other campers. Please always pick up their excrement
- Visitors must always be announced at the reception when they arrive and they must also respect the rules of the campsite. They must leave the campsite by 10:00 p.m. at the latest.
- It is strictly forbidden to light a campfire on your property. Only standing barbecues or braziers are allowed. Always keep a bucket of water handy. Persistent drought may lead to a general ban. Such a situation will of course be announced.
- Children cannot play at the entrance to the campsite, on the access avenue, at the height of the barrier and the terrace. Avoid playing in the streets, it could be dangerous with cars.
- The direction can refuse or put a camper outside in case of doubts or bad behavior of the camper. In this case, no refund can be made.
- The reception is open from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and from 2:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. If there is no one at reception you can always call +32 71 61 26 32. Please respect this schedule.

If you have any questions, you can always ask at reception.
